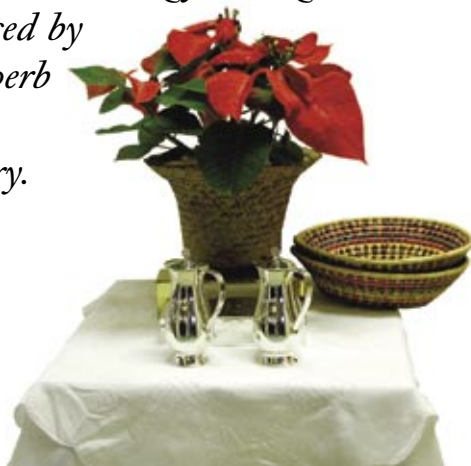


ALL ARE WELCOME

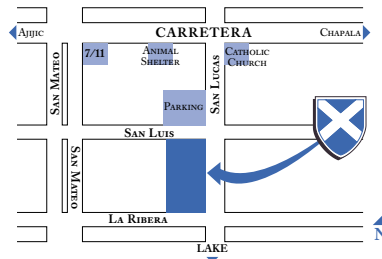

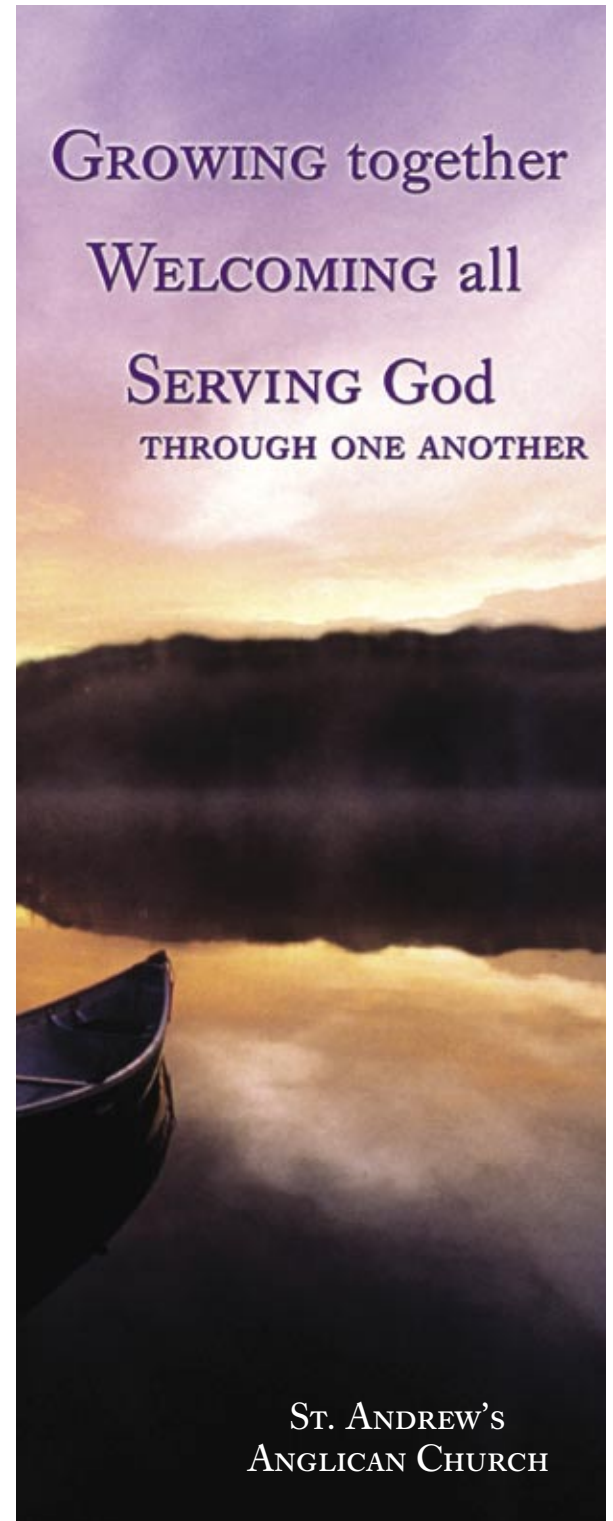

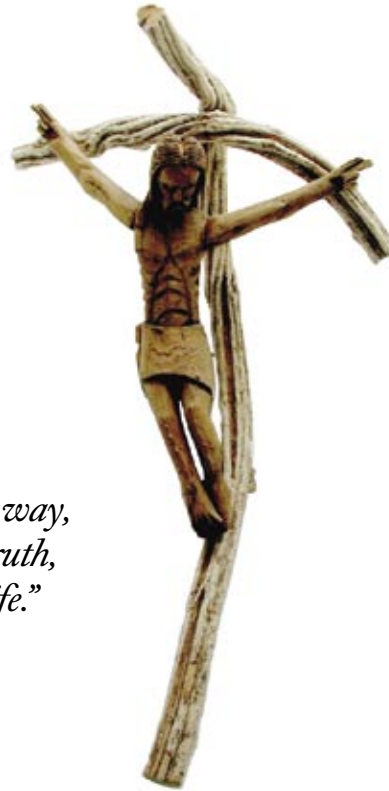
ST. ANDREW'S OFFERS SPIRITUAL DEVELOPMENT & PERSONAL GROWTH
